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Overview

Benefits of RdSAP GO Floor Plan

- Saves time and avoids the need for data entry when back at the office
- Saves time manually drawing floor plans before and during the assessment
- Data points from the floor plan can be transferred into the RdSAP Go App without the need for an internet connection
- The floor plan image is uploaded along with your photographic evidence to evidence online ready for audit.
- Clear, detailed floor plans making the audit process smoother and quicker with less reasons to fail.
- Plan up still available in RdSAP Go to create estate agent quality floor plans
- Free for 6 months, then 25p per lodgement

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Specifications/Devices

Due to the number of available devices currently on the market we cannot guarantee that RdSAP GO Floor plan tool will be fully compatible with every device.

- Can be used on both a phone or iPad (not online software)
- **IOS only.** Android version will be coming soon
- The newer the device the better the software will work (we know 8th generation 2020, works but is slow/clunky)
- Devices with less than 5GB RAM will be slow and clunky and may crash
- We can only support what IOS versions apple support – currently IOS versions 18 and 26, this changes yearly.

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Data Transfer.

During the floor plan creation process, various data items can be transferred between Floor plan and RdSAP GO these are as follows:

- Number of stories
- Dimensions for main building + any extensions (Area, Height, HLP, PW)
- Number of rooms (habitable/non-habitable)
- External doors and Draught proofed doors
- Windows dimensions, orientation and numbering to RdSAP GO. Each window will need to be completed in RdSAP Go (age banding etc)
- Conservatory, Thermally separated and none thermally separated plus glazing perimeter.
- Room in Roof area
- Lighting including type and number of LED's and CFL's
