THREE MAIN LINES OF EFFORT:

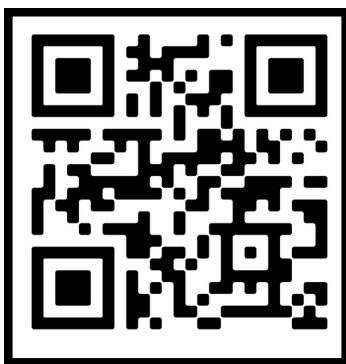
Training for First Responders

Training is worth 2 hours of POST Credit for law enforcement and CEUs for EMS in Missouri.
